
ANNUAL MATHLYMPICS FOR ALL SINGAPORE PRIMARY SCHOOLS 2015

- 1) This competition is open to all students enrolled in Primary 4 and 5 in the local schools in 2015. Topics will include Arithmetic, Number Theory, Combinatorics, Logic, Geometry, Measurement and Algebra.

2) **Preliminary Round**

Date : **13th August 2015, Thursday**
Time : 2.00 pm to 3.30 pm
Venue : Participating schools' own premises

Format of the Paper in the Preliminary Round

Duration: 1½ hours
Consists of only the Vault Event comprising 28 questions.

Marks are allotted as follows:

Questions 1 to 10: 2 marks each
Questions 11 to 20: 4 marks each
Questions 21 to 28: 5 marks each

Use of calculators is **NOT ALLOWED**.

Results of the Preliminary Round competition will be posted on the Anglo-Chinese School (Independent) website at http://www.acs.sch.edu.sg/acs_indep/main.php after 16th September 2015.

3) **Final Round**

Only the top 25% participants or the top 500 participants, whichever is lower, will qualify to compete for the awards of Gold, Silver and Bronze in the Final Round.

Date : **26th September 2015, Saturday**
Time : 9.00 am to 11.00 am
Venue : Anglo-Chinese School (Independent) Old Multi-Purpose Hall

The Final Round will take place on 26th September 2015. As the session involves the participation of about 500 students from more than 80 schools, there will be no alternative arrangements made in the event of a clash of schedules. This is to ensure fairness and the integrity of the competition and we ask for your understanding on this matter. Finalists who were absent from the Final Round will be awarded Certificate of Merit.

Format of the Paper in the Finals

The Finals consists of the Vault Event and the Sprint Event.

a) Vault Event

Duration: 1½ hours
28 questions.

Marks are allotted as follows:

Questions 1 to 10: 2 marks each
Questions 11 to 20: 4 marks each
Questions 21 to 28: 5 marks each

b) Sprint Event

Duration: ½ hour

50 questions

Each question carries 1 mark. Marks will be awarded for correct answers only.

Participants will be provided with Casio calculators for use in both events.

Marks will be awarded for correct answers only. There will be ***no deduction of marks for error or omissions*** for both the Preliminary Round and the Finals. All decisions made by the organizers and judges will be final.

Results of the Final Round will be announced at the Awards Presentation Ceremony on **17th October 2015, Saturday**. The results will be posted on the Anglo-Chinese School (Independent) website after **19th October 2015**.

4) **Awards Presentation Ceremony**

The ceremony will be opened to staff representatives of all participating schools and all finalists.

Date : **17th October 2015, Saturday**

Time : 9.00 am to 10.00 am

Venue : Anglo-Chinese School (Independent) Centre for Performing Arts 1

5) **Prizes**

Gold Award Certificates will be awarded to the top 15% of the finalists.

Silver Award Certificates will be awarded to the next 25% of the finalists.

Bronze Award Certificates will be awarded to the remaining finalists.

Certificate of Merit will be awarded to finalists who were absent from the Final Round.

All other participants will be awarded Certificate of Participation.

Schools will be ranked according to the tally of gold, silver and bronze awards, **in that order**, obtained by their pupils. The top 5 schools will receive trophies and cash awards. The top 3 schools, not including the 5 schools already receiving prizes, with the highest medal count will receive Honourable Mention Awards, the prize of which is a trophy for the school.

First Prize: \$1000 in cash, 1 trophy for the school and the Challenge Trophy

Second Prize: \$500 in cash, 1 trophy for the school

Third Prize: \$400 in cash, 1 trophy for the school

Fourth Prize: \$300 in cash, 1 trophy for the school

Fifth Prize: \$200 in cash, 1 trophy for the school

Three Honourable Mention Prizes: 1 trophy for the school

The Champion School shall keep the Challenge Trophy and shall return it to Anglo-Chinese School (Independent) for the next competition. The Challenge Trophy shall be kept permanently by the school, which emerges champion in three consecutive competitions.

Individual Prizes will be awarded to the overall top 3 participants, in addition to the top 3 participants of each of the 4 school zones.
